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1 Installing the THWi contact tracing app

By clicking on the question mark symbol in the upper left corner, the app can be installed directly, i.e. linked to the home screen.

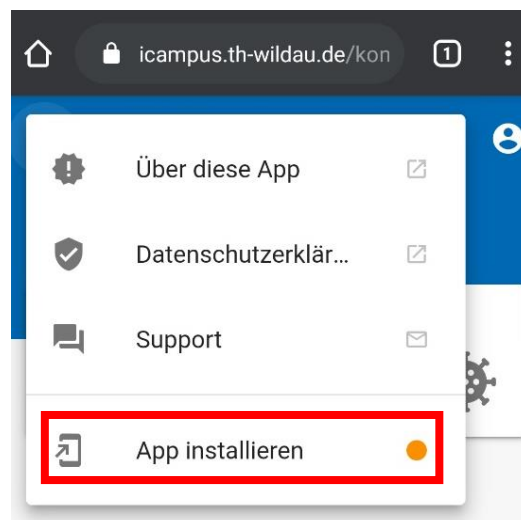


Abbildung 2: App installieren

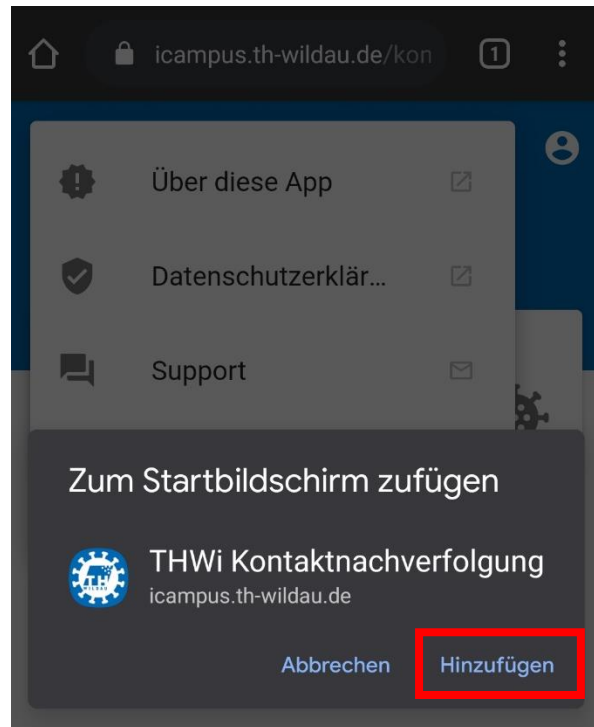



Abbildung 3: THWi-Kontaktnachverfolgung hinzufügen

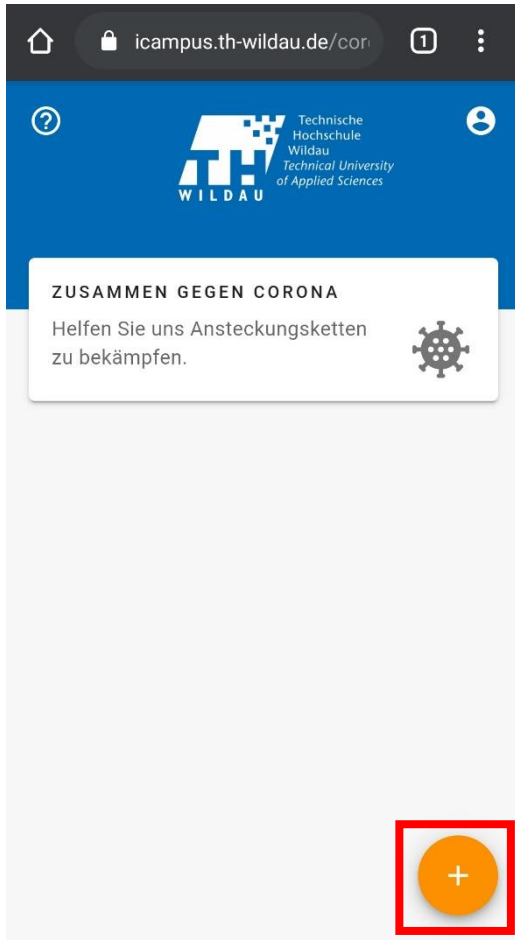


Abbildung 7: QR-Code hinzufügen

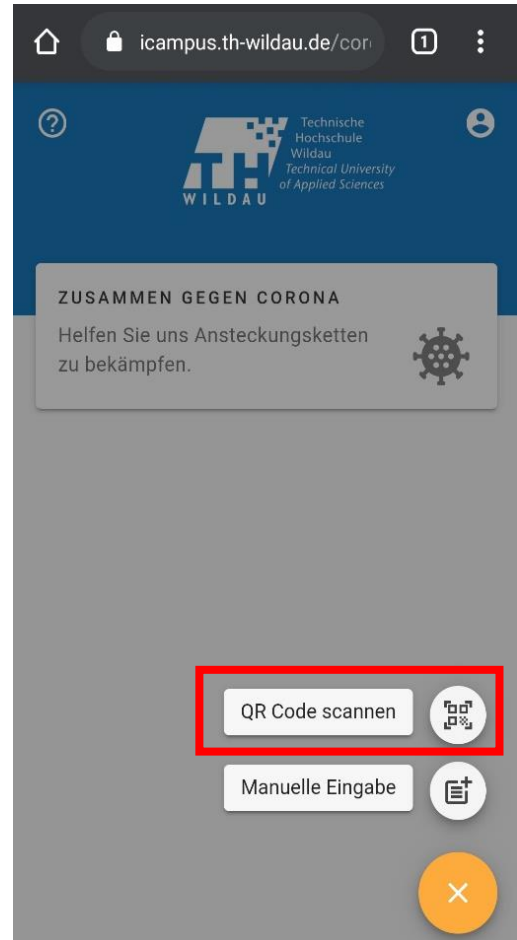


Abbildung 8: QR-Code scannen

You can also manually enter a room using the room list. To do so, you must press the "+" at the bottom right of the web page to add a visit. A selection window will then appear. Select "Manual entry".

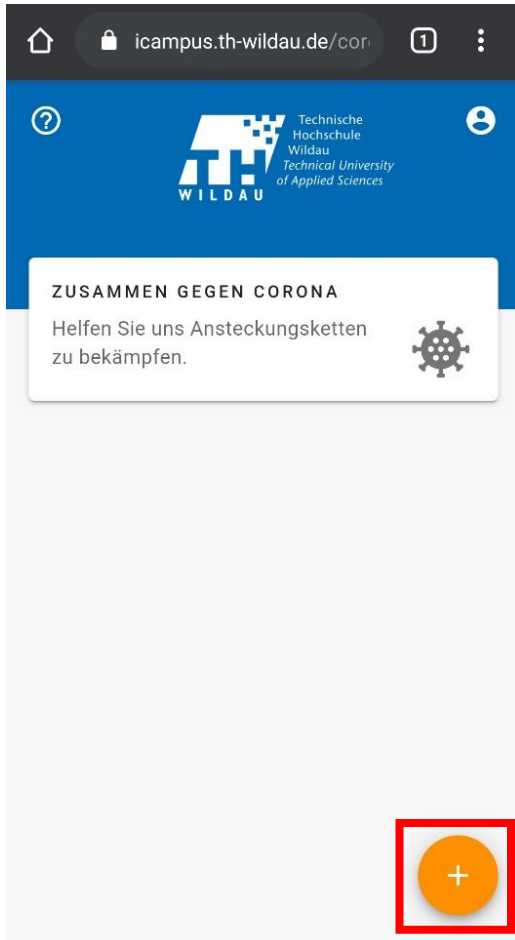


Abbildung 9: Manuell hinzufügen

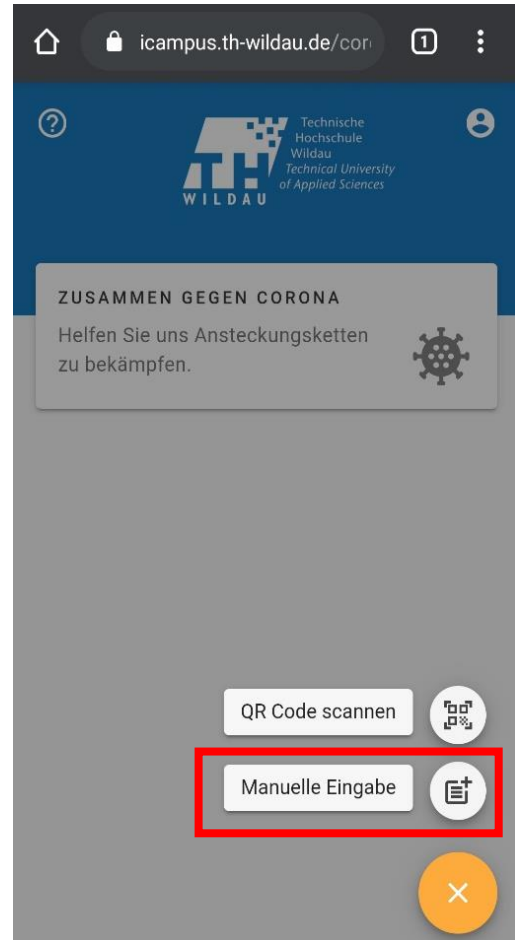
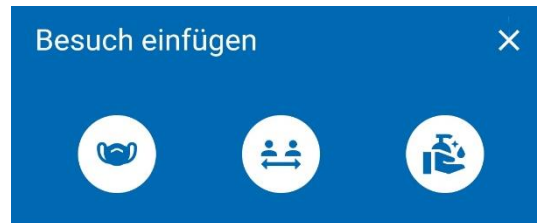


Abbildung 10: Manuelle Eingabe

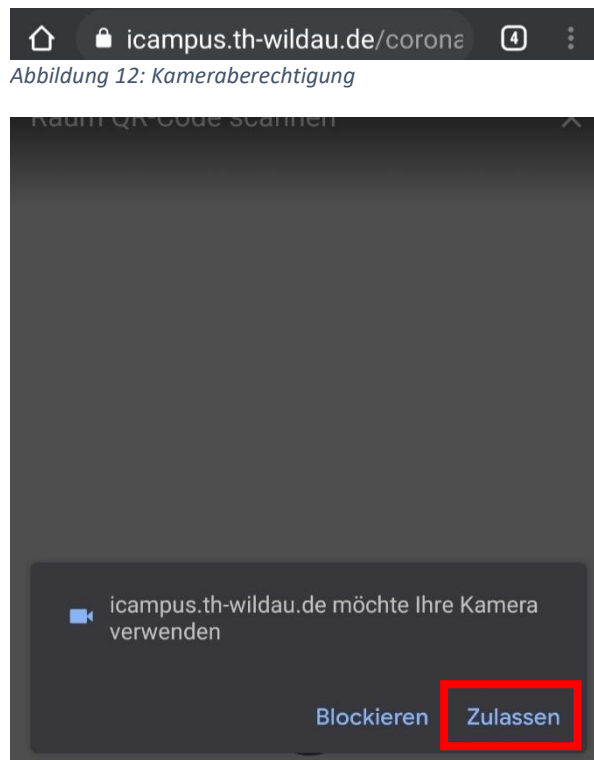

4 Camera permissions for Chrome

Navigate to the page <https://icampus.th-wildau.de/kontaktnachverfolgung/> via Chrome on your smartphone.

If you want to scan a QR code via the page, you must first give permission to do so. The first time a camera request is made by a website, you will be asked permission via a pop-up.



Chrome also requires confirmation.

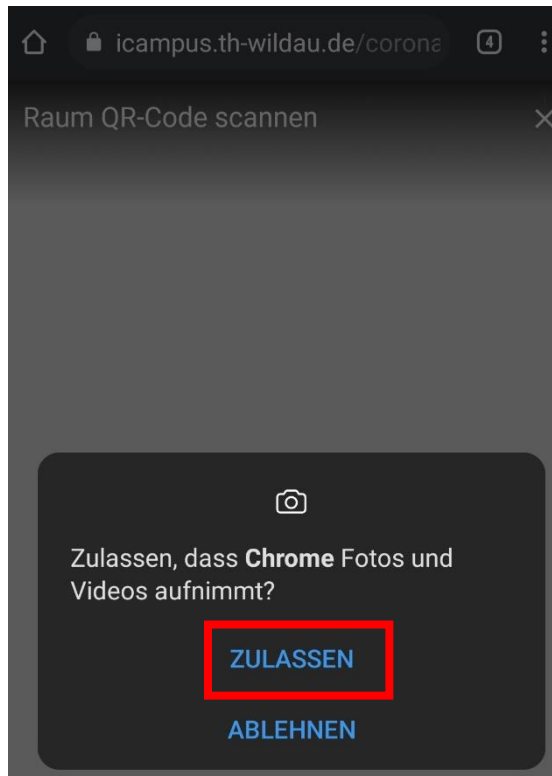


Abbildung 13: Kameraberechtigung Chrome

If you want to change the permissions in your browser manually, you have to tap on the three dots in the upper right corner and then on "Settings".

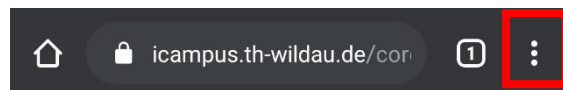


Abbildung 14: Kameraberechtigung Chrome manuell

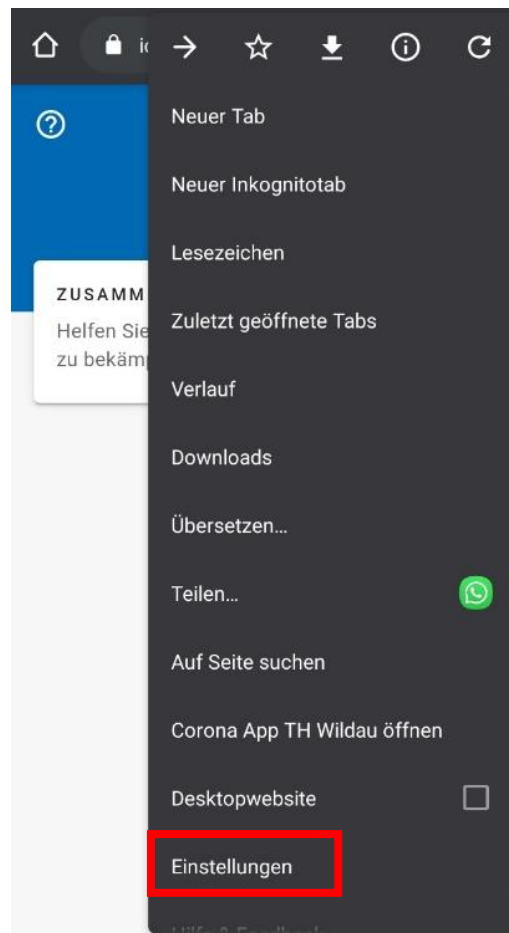


Abbildung 15: Kameraberechtigung Chrome - Einstellungen

Go to "Site settings" in the advanced settings.

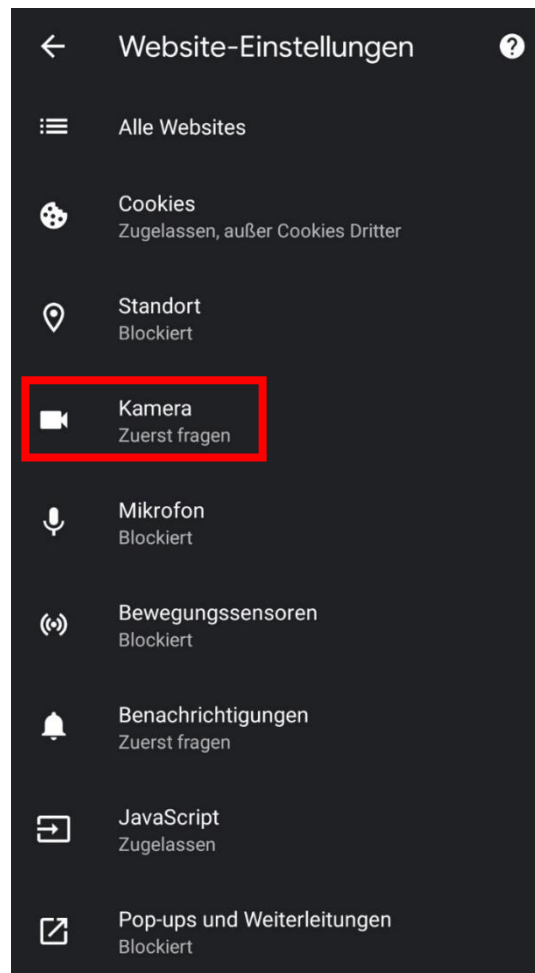


Abbildung 16: Chrome Website-Einstellung

You will now be redirected to the website settings. Under "Camera" you can grant the authorization.

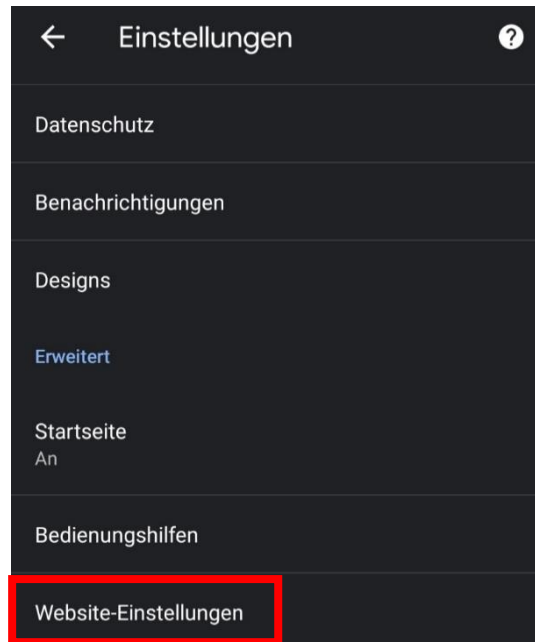


Abbildung 17: Chrome Website-Einstellung

If you want to scan a QR code via the page, you must first give permission to do so. You can choose between *Allow permanently* or *Ask every time*.

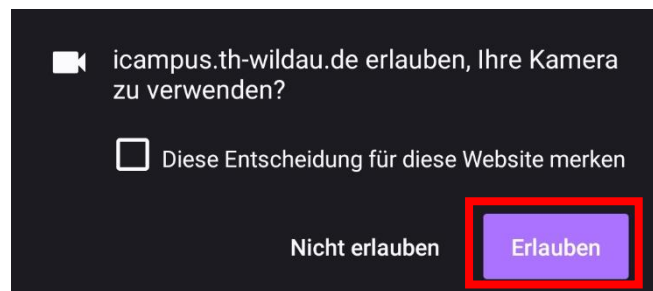


Abbildung 19: Kameraberechtigung Firefox

If Firefox does not yet have permission to access your camera, tap on the three dots at the bottom right and then to Settings.

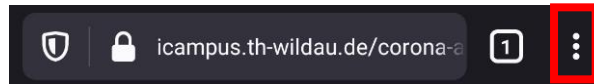


Abbildung 20: Kameraberechtigung manuell

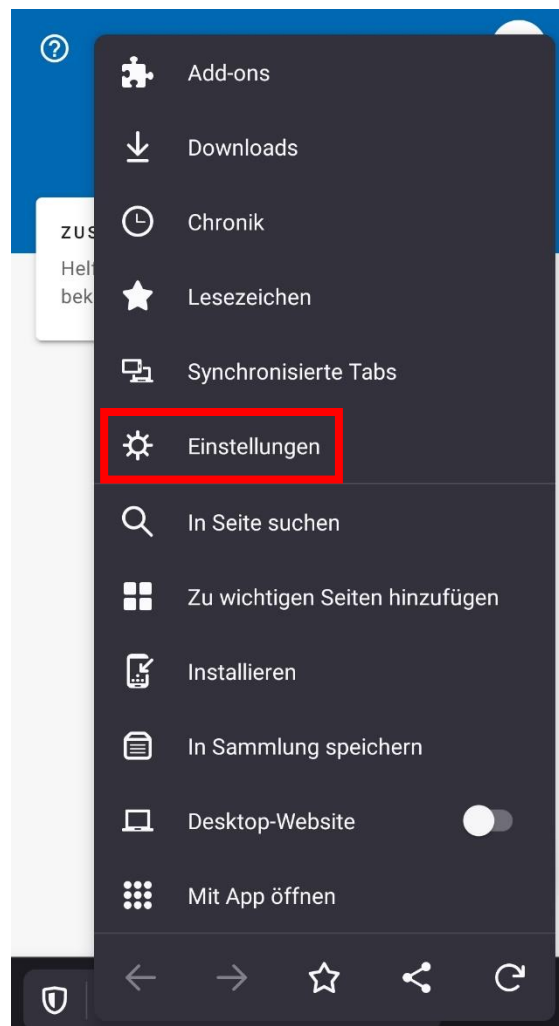


Abbildung 21: Firefox-Einstellungen

You will now be redirected to the website permissions. Under "Camera" you can assign the permission.

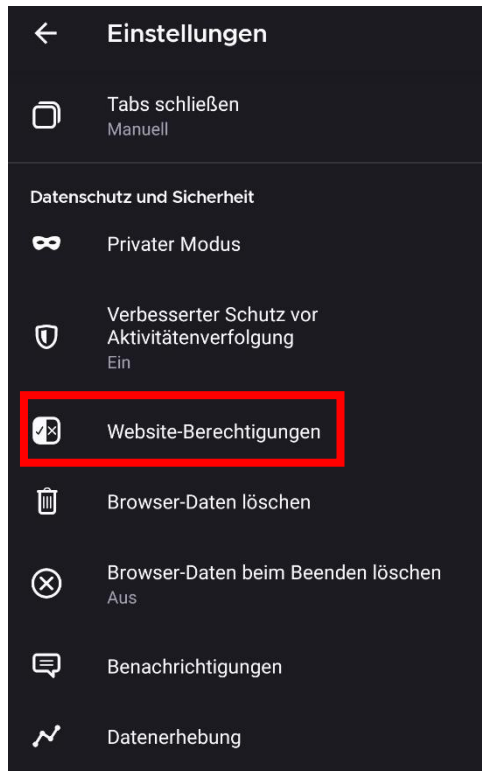


Abbildung 232: Firefox Website-Einstellungen

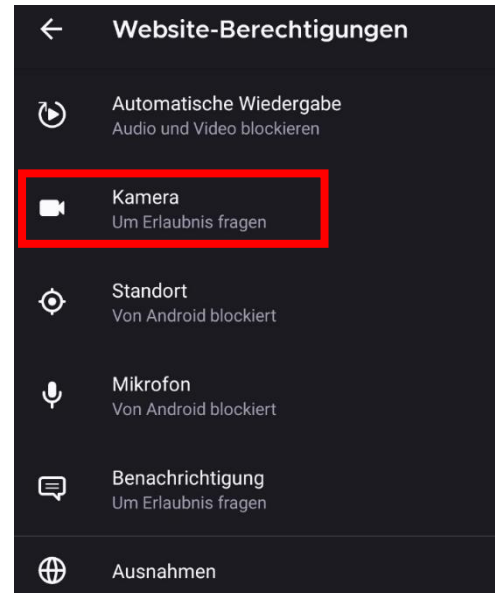


Abbildung 223: Website-Einstellungen Kamera
