The **Wildau Foundation Year** and the **Welcome Centre** for Refugees prepare prospective international students for studies at TH Wildau (and at partner universities).

The courses prepare students for the university entrance examination in terms of subject matter and for the DSH examination in terms of language.

Language preparation:

- German
- Technical or business German
- English as a foreign language

Subject preparation:

- Mathematics
- Physics/engineering or economics
- Computer Science
- Presentation techniques
- Academic methods
- Intercultural skills
- Laboratory practicals and first seminars
- Preparation for the German labour market

In addition, both programmes offer support for everyday university life. They help with:

- Orientation on campus
- Organising cultural activities

INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

The International Office is your first point of contact if you are planning to go abroad from the TH Wildau (outgoings) – or to come to the TH Wildau from abroad (incomings).

Outgoings

The International Office provides information about shorter and longer stays abroad during your studies, from intensive workshops and summer schools to internships lasting several months to one or more semesters of study.

It supports stays at partner universities of the TH Wildau as well as so-called 'free movers' who go abroad on their own initiative or through agencies.

The International Office advises on the funding programmes of the European Union, the German Academic Exchange Service and the Fulbright Foundation, among others, as well as on BAföG abroad. In addition, it ensures the recognition of academic achievements and the conversion of grades.

The International Office supports students, teachers and employees from abroad before and during their stay at the TH Wildau.
